BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES:

William H. Abbott was a cabinetmaker in Fisherville NH. The papers show that he had a sister, Ami. M. Dunklee (Mrs. G.W.), in Milford and had a relation, perhaps a brother, Jacob Abbott married to H.S. and living in Nashua. His wife was Addie Connor from Henniker, the daughter of E.K. Connor. Addie's brother Frank Connor lived St. Augustine, Florida. He sister H.E. Rogers lived in Litchfield and brother Lendell A. Connor was with the Internal Revenue Service in Washington, D.C.

SCOPE & CONTENT NOTE:

The bulk of this collection consists of the diaries/accounts of William H. Abbott. Diary and personal account entries were kept intermixed in yearly volumes of standard pocket diaries. Entries include weather, travel, hours worked each day, who he saw, letters written and jobs accomplished (for example: Wed. April 30th, 1860, "finished a job of 50 four dr bureaus". There are also receipts for groceries and milk as well as for lumber and city water.
