Summary:

The collection is comprised of 11 volumes of handwritten hotel ledgers, registers, and checkbook stubs of building expenses and guest accounts.

Overview

The Eagle Mountain House and Hall, Jackson, NH, had been continually under one-family management for many years. Located on the side of Eagle Mountain on a square-mile plot of land, it sat above Jackson Village and near the famous, picturesque Jackson Falls. The first building, Eagle Hall, was built in 1879 and the Eagle Mountain House was added in 1890. It was primarily a summer hotel, yet remained open all seasons for special parties. Guests in the nineteenth century could reach the Eagle Mountain House by rail (the Maine Central and Boston & Maine) to the Glen House, where a carriage would be provided for their four-mile ride to the Eagle Mountain House. The Eagle Mountain House was completely rebuilt in 1915.
