SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

This collection is arranged chronologically. It consists mainly of correspondence between the architect, managers, contractors and insurance people involved with the building and running of the Mt. Pleasant Hotel and the management of the company. Correspondents include: John Conyngham, President, and Robert Jenks, Treasurer of the Bretton Woods Co., Anderson & Price and A.P. McLaughlin were managers, John C. Paige with the insurance company, E.A. Richardson with the railroad, architect Frances H. Fassett and others.

Box 1: N.H. billheads, boards, nails, & paint, well digging, water analysis, reroofing, furnishings, crockery, tinware, electricity, land purchases;

Box 2: architect's conditions of contract, steam heat, power house, water tank, windows, elevator, wallpaper, kitchen fixtures, contract to build "bachelors quarters" & stable keeper's house;

Box 3: electricity contractors, ice house, footbridge over railroad, desc. of hotel in Maine Central RR publications, music, laundry, furniture, carpentry, letter to Abbot-Downing re wagons, windmill, bedsteads, lap robes, silverware, coffee pots, menus, groceries, rattan furniture, billiards tables, coal, Sabbath desecrated by workmen, bowling alley, rocking chairs, accounts Aug 1895 3 guests, what paid, # employees, what paid;

Box 4: coal, Sept. 1895 inventory of supplies, closing for winter, digging pond, boiler and plumbing, three accounts of guest & where from, trial balance, liquor list;

Box 5: well water tests, book keepers report, blueprints of passenger station Maine Central/Bretton Woods moved to blueprint drawer;

Box 6: cold storage plant, roof leaks, advertizing, RR time schedules, ticket taking, liquor licenses, repainting, Italian work crews, kitchen ceiling falling in soup;

Box 7: Forest conservation management program with USDA., sewage and septic ugly and produce rumors of causing tonsillitis, flood & relandscaping 1903;

Box 8: sale of timber on land, old barn for teams converted for automobiles, purchasing land, payment of contractors, payroll, J.J. Quint farm;

Box 9: ordering produce, meeting of Board of directors, automobile show publicity, travel sluggish, cost cutbacks;

Box 10: logging & portable mill, roads, purchase of ice Dec 12, 1904 consider name change from Mt. Pleasant Hotel Co. to Bretton Woods Hotel, Co., motion picture booth billing, chapel expense, telephones, hot water boilers, inventories, White Mtn. Beverage Co., finances & supplies
