

## New Hampshire Conference United Church of Christ

### Background Notes:

The New Hampshire Missionary Society was organized in 1801 for the purpose of carrying a Christian Ministry and the preaching of the Gospel to the people in the "Northern settlements: of New England." This society began a home missionary task in New Hampshire, which has been the major concern of the conference even now. The conference program was the extension of the religious work in our state beyond the local parish. In 1951 the conference was a working fellowship of 187 New Hampshire churches with a membership of 29,000 people.

### Scope and Content:

This collection contains New Hampshire conference United Church of Christ records, dating from the early 1800s. In general, the collection consists of
