MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

At the Society's 2005 annual meeting, I spoke about plans to grow and strengthen our organization by doing three things: serving the needs of current and prospective members; being accessible no matter where one lives; and maintaining our reputation as the first place to turn for answers on New Hampshire's history. We are making great progress on these objectives, and I am pleased to share with you some of the things we are doing to make the Society—and specifically our collections—more accessible to the public.



When we give someone a tour of our museum storage area, the most frequently asked question is, “how often do you put this stuff on display?” The unfortunate answer is that we can display at most 3.5 percent of our museum collections at one time. Put another way, it would take twenty-nine years to display our entire collection if each exhibition lasted one year. And, as for our library archives, they can only be accessed during regular business hours.

The Society has amassed an enormous amount of material over its 183 years. We have 29,000 museum objects; 50,000 bound volumes; 1,500,000 pages of manuscripts; 800,000 pages of newspapers; 200,000 photographs; and 10,000 broadsides and ephemera items. We continue to add to our collections while at the same time trying to meet the demands of a public that is pressed for time and has ever higher expectations for service. So the question is: How do we make ourselves more convenient and easier to experience? The answer is through the use of technology, collaboration, and good old-fashioned collections processing.

First, we need to make our collections more accessible through our Web site. Our current online catalog allows you to find an item, but it does not allow you to see an image of it. And, in many cases, the description of the object is too limited. To address this, we are in the process of upgrading to new software that will allow us to attach images to the item descriptions and to provide better search features. To prepare for this transition, we are going back through the collections to capture an image of each item and to do the necessary research to provide better narrative descriptions for the catalog.

We are also making strides to extend our reach throughout the state. Thanks to a grant from the Corporate Fund, we completed a survey of local historical society members—and we are now surveying local society leaders—to determine how we can help them better care for their collections and make their organizations stronger.

And, in recognition that New Hampshire is a state with strong regional identities, we are seeking out venues around the state where we will hold regular traveling exhibitions. We are hoping that the convenience of having our exhibitions closer to where people live will increase our membership in those communities and regions. The first satellite exhibition venue will open at the historic Mount Washington Hotel in August 2006.

All of these plans would not be possible without strong financial resources. This is why we take every opportunity to thank you for your support, and to remember those who have treated us as a loved one.

I want to share with you the legacy of one of our fellow members—June Campbell Hoyt of Manchester. June was a member of the Society from 1998 to 2005, when she passed away. She bequeathed the Society one-half of her estate—a gift of nearly \$400,000. In her memory, we have placed the entire amount directly into the endowment in a separate fund in her name. The June Campbell Hoyt Fund will now provide the Society \$20,000 per year in income in perpetuity. We thank June for her remarkable gift. And, we thank you—our loyal members—for all of your support.
