

Some Schoolhouses to Visit

Lockhaven Schoolhouse Museum

on Crystal Lake, Enfield, NH
1864 one-room schoolhouse, restored, with local memorabilia.
Open June 10-Sept.30, Sundays 2-5 pm or by appointment.

Newport Little Red Schoolhouse

on Route 10, 2 1/2 miles South of Newport.
One-room schoolhouse dates from c. 1835.
Open July 4- Labor Day on Wednesdays from 1-4 pm.

Nottingham Schoolhouse Museum

on Route 156 at Nottingham Square.
Upstairs furnished as schoolroom.
Open June 16- September 29 by appointment.

Dame School in Nottingham

on Route 152, Nottingham.
Originally constructed as a meetinghouse c. 1840.
Now incorporated into modern school complex.

District Number 2 Schoolhouse, "Little Red Schoolhouse"

in Wakefield, on Route 153, 1/2 mile East of Route 16.
Brick schoolhouse built in 1858-9 with 1971 addition.
Maintained by the Wakefield-Brookfield Historical Society.

High Tops School

at the intersection of Poocham and River roads, Westmoreland.
Built in 1789 and remodeled in 1846. Contains local memorabilia.
Maintained by the Westmoreland Corner School Historical Association.
