Abstract:

This collection contains material from three generations of the Abbot family, with the majority the collection consisting of papers from George Abbot. George Abbot was a surveyor and estate administrator who was interested in history. His papers contain a small amount of personal correspondence as well as surveyor notes, travel accounts, legal documents relating to the estates he handled, and material he generated for his historical research. There are also four bound volumes: three of them Justice of the Peace records (1830-1887), and a farmer's daybook (1857-1886). A few items concern George Abbot's father, Ezra, who served in the Revolutionary War under General John Stark. George's son, George Abbot, Jr., is also represented by 13 bound volumes that include a daybook, check stub book, and account books (1866-1892).

Collection Overview

Biographical Information:

Ezra Abbot, son of George (1706–1785) and Sarah (1711–1769) Abbot, was born August 24, 1756 at Concord, NH. Ezra Abbot served in the Revolutionary War and was with General John Stark in the battle of Bennington, VT, in 1777. He married three times, first to Betty, daughter of Thomas and Mary (Burnham) Andrews, born May 12, 1762, on November 21, 1782. She died in Concord on August 25, 1794. Ezra married second Anner Choate (b. 1758) on May 10, 1795 at Boscawen. She died March 21, 1798 at Concord. Ezra married third Jane Jackman on November 15, 1798 at Boscawen, born December 20, 1767, daughter of Benjamin and Jane (Woodman) Jackman. Ezra served as a surveyor of highways for Concord, NH, for a number of years. Ezra died at Concord on February 21, 1837. Jane died there on May 2, 1847.

George Abbot, born January 27, 1803 at Concord, was the son of Ezra and Jane (Jackman) Abbot. George married Eliza D. Spaulding, daughter of John and Betsey (Wheeler) Spaulding, on August 25, 1836 at Lebanon. They had two children: George, born November 13, 1838, and

Betsey Jane, born February 9, 1849. Eliza D. died at Concord on October 11, 1856. George Sr. then married at Concord on December 31, 1861 Clarissa Carter, daughter of Bela and Julia (Carter) Carter, born August 18, 1815 at Concord. She died March 14, 1882 at Concord. George died at Concord on May 8, 1887. George followed his father into the profession of surveying. He also served as administrator for a number of estates, was a Justice of Peace, and interested in history.

George Jr. married at Concord on April 5, 1864 Joanna G. Fiske, daughter of John and Elizabeth (Kitteredge) Fiske, born August 14, 1844 at Concord. They had one child Herbert George born at Concord on March 12, 1865. George was a painter and paperhanger. Joanna died at Concord on January 26, 1919. George died at Concord on August 30, 1928.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The largest portion of the George Abbot Papers consists of travel accounts of travel in New Hampshire and Massachusetts, Justice of the Peace records, survey notes, and maps created by George Abbot. Also included are survey reports and field books, including one for Contoocook, NH, and one for the Concord, NH, School District No. 4. There are also papers of more than ten persons for whom George Abbot served as estate administrator. The materials in the collection include originals and handwritten copies of items dating from 1730 to 1892.

The collection also includes George Abbot's notes on the history of Concord, NH, and vital records collected by Mrs. C.C. [Clarissa Carter] Abbot. George Abbot's memoranda and history includes information on a variety of topics, including Christopher Columbus, Hannah Duston's capture, a snowstorm of 1717, earthquake of 1727, and "The Dark Day Friday" of May 19, 1780 (see Box 2, folder 13). A small miscellaneous folder contains locks of hair sewn onto paper, correspondence, and a request for a Revolutionary War pension for John Blanchard of Dunbarton, NH. Other materials of interest are the Revolutionary War pension papers of George's father, Ezra Abbot, and thirteen bound volumes that appear to have belonged to George Abbot's son, George, and contain accounts kept from 1865-1892.

Arrangement:

The materials in this collection have been arranged into folders by person, then by subject. Bound volumes are in two boxes at the end of the collection.
