Abstract:

This collection consists largely of photographs and other materials created by the Dudley, Sargent, and Conway families from 1871 to 1947. It includes photographs and newspaper clippings from a photograph album and scrapbook kept by Barbara Bell Conway, the great-granddaughter of Hubbard and Antoinette Dudley, and a granddaughter of Harry G. Sargent, who was the 1901 Mayor of Concord, New Hampshire.

The Sargent, Dudley, and Conway Family Photograph Collection was a gift of the John B. Conway family on July 19, 2012.

Processing Information:

This collection was processed by Stephen Leavenworth in August 2012. The finding aid was written by Stephen Leavenworth in August 2012 and revised by Rebecca Enman in February 2013. This finding aid follows the standards set forth by *Describing Archives: A Content Standard*.

The photograph album and scrapbook in this collection were disassembled during processing, the photographs inserted in sleeves, and the newspaper clippings photocopied.

Collection Overview

Biographical Information:

Harry Gene Sargent was born in Pittsfield, NH, on September 30, 1859 to Samuel M. and Cyrene (Mitchell) Sargent. Early on, his family moved to Concord, NH, where Harry received his education in the public schools, graduating in June 1878. He studied law under W. T. & H. F. Norris before attending Boston University Law School from 1879 to 1880 and then studying under J. Y. Mugridge from 1880 to 1881. Sargent was admitted to the bar in August 1881, entering practice in Concord, NH, and working with several partners: Sargent & Hollis; Sargent, Hollis & Niles; and Sargent, Niles & Morrill.

Harry Sargent married Elizabeth Dudley at Concord on December 14, 1881. She was the daughter of Hubbard T. and Antoinette (Gordon) Dudley, born April 5, 1857 at Concord, NH. Elizabeth had one child, Margaret D. Sargent (1883–1962). Harry worked as Merrimack County Solicitor from 1885 to 1887, and as Concord City Solicitor from 1887 to 1901. Sargent was elected Mayor of Concord in 1901. He died in Concord on September 7, 1908. Lizzie died there on June 7, 1942.

Margaret D. Sargent married William T. Bell at Concord on January 6, 1909, the son of Andrew and Elizabeth B. (McKellar) Bell, born on September 9, 1884 at New Bedford, MA. Their daughter, Barbara Bell, the great-granddaughter of Peter and Antoinette Dudley, graduated from Concord High School in 1930, and married John Conway in 1935.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The Sargent, Dudley, and Conway Family Photograph Collection, 1871-1947, includes photographs, newspaper clippings, and ephemera taken from a photograph album dated 1925-1932 and a scrapbook dated 1947, which was kept by Barbara Bell Conway. The bulk of this collection is comprised of photographs, many of which are identified and include images of travel, Tall Pines Camp, and family photographs, including an image of Harry Sargent meeting President Teddy Roosevelt in Concord, NH, in 1902. Also included are ten unidentified stereographs.

Other materials include a few letters from Winston Churchill, programs, wedding and graduation invitations, a Christmas card, obituaries, political newspaper clippings of both family and politicians of the time (John Winant, Roosevelt, etc.), telegraphs, miscellaneous newspaper clippings, and a family tree of the Dudley family genealogy, which chronicles the family from Charlemagne in 814 to Thomas Dudley in 1376.

An index of the photograph captions, dates, and subjects found in the scrapbook and album has been created and included at the end of this finding aid. Please note that spelling of places, names, and other titles have not been corrected; they are listed in the index as they appear in the photograph album.
