Collection Overview

Biographical Information/ Administrative Information:

The West Concord Garden Club was started in February of 1938. The first president was Agnes Johnson. The object of the group was to "promote a greater interest in gardening and to exchange experiences that shall be of mutual benefit to its members." Members all had to be actively involved in gardening. There were to be 50 members holding monthly meetings and sponsoring an annual flower show. The club held program talks on topics such as herbs, plant disease, perennials, and flower arranging. They were very active in the Hopkinton Fair and often won ribbons for their entries. They sponsored civil improvements from the Concord City Park manager regarding the damage from the 1938 hurricane. With the last of their treasury, they purchased a granite memorial bench for the Sewell's Falls Park in West Concord.

Collection Scope and Content Note:
