Collection Overview

Biographical Information:

Althea C. Boxell was born in Everett, MA, on January 19, 1910 to Clifford A. and Annie M. (Perkins) Boxell. Althea lived in Everett until the 1920s when the family moved to Auburn, MA. She worked as stenographer in a furniture store and for the town clerk. Althea died in Holden, MA, on October 4, 1988 and is buried in the Provincetown Cemetery in Provincetown, MA.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The Althea C. Boxell Photograph Collection consists of photographs of covered bridges in New Hampshire, taken between approximately the early 1960s and 1990. This estimation is derived from dates on some of the photographs, though the majority of the photographs are undated. Many bridges are represented by numerous photographs showing differing views. The bridges are not limited to functional road bridges, but also include bridges over creeks, etc., on private land. Ornamental bridges, such as garden ornaments are included. It is not known if the photographs were taken by Boxell or collected by Boxell.

The photographs are arranged alphabetically into folders by the name of the town.
