Abstract:

The collection is in three pats. One part is items recording events surrounding the 50th wedding anniversary of Zedekiah Smith Barstow (1790-1873) and Elizabeth Fay Blake. He was a Congregational minister in Keene NH, a trustee of Dartmouth College and held many church and educational offices. The second part is personal correspondence and word games of Josiah Whitney Barstow (1826-1922), a physician and director of a hospital for the insane in Flushing NY for forty years. The third part is genealogical notes on the Barstow and Blake families and a small amount of seemingly unrelated material that belonged to Samuel L. Mitchell.

Collection Overview

Biographical Information:

Zedekiah Smith Barstow (1790-1873) was born in Canterbury CT. He graduated from Yale University in 1813, tutored at Hamilton College and served as college chaplain. He married Elizabeth Fay Blake in 1818. That same year, he became the minister of the Congregational Church in Keene NH, where he served for over thirty years. He was a trustee of Dartmouth College and held many church and educational offices.

Josiah Whitney Barstow (1826-1922) was born in Keene NH. He graduated from Dartmouth Medical School and from Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons in 1853. He married Flora MacDonald in 1865. For forty years, he was Director of Sanford Hall, a hospital for the insane in Flushing NY.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The bulk of the Zedekiah Smith Barstow papers center on his Golden Wedding anniversary in 1868 and his obituary and cemetery lot in 1873.

The Josiah Whitney Barstow papers are mainly personal correspondence, including a number of word games.

There are genealogical notes on both the Barstow and Blake families.

The materials relating to Samuel L. Mitchell do not have an apparent connection to the rest of the collection. They are mainly library passes for universities in England.
