- Everett, Edward (1794-1865) Letters, 1827-1865. 8 ALS. See also inscription in vol. of orations presented to NHHS July 30, 1830.
- Flint, Timothy (1780-1840) Letter to William Low, Concord Post Master Cincinnati, April 3, 1830 - re translation of a french work.
- Frost, Robert (1894-1963) Letter to Miss Bennett, S. Shaftsbury, VT. 1930 June 24 - joining NHHS.
- Halleck, Fitz-Greene (1790-1867) 2 ALS Two brief notes, Guilford Conn. 1854 Dec. 9 - to Major A>D> Benham; 1857 Aug 13 - to Capt. Benham, U>S> Army
- Holmes, Oliver Wendell (1809-1894) 1 MS; 2 ALS, 1853 Feb 24, Concord, NH- rhyme 4 lines; 1866 March 7 lecture to dear Sir; 1880, Nov 22, letter to Mrs. Botta, re portrait of Dorothy Quincy.
- Howe, Julia (Ward) (1819-1910), Letter to Mrs. Benham, NP, Dec 27, Regrets cannot attend this evening.
- Howells, William Dean, "The Sarcastic Fair", a poem. Columbus Ohio, 1860.

Jackson, Helen Hunt (1831-1885), Letters to Mrs. Benham, 1873, 5 items. Author. Brief letters to friend, only one of them dated, from Newport, March 26, 1873. Three signed Helen Hunt; two signed Helen Jackson (written after 1875)

Page, Thomas Nelson (1853-1922) Letter to Gov. Frank W. Rollins, Washington 1904 Dec 9, old home week in Virginia.

Palfrey, John G. (1796-1881) 2 ALS, 1844 Aug. 26 to Gov. of NH (John H. Steele) sending copy of Mass. reports. (Sec. office); 1860 Feb 22 - to Mr. Leighton.

Phillips, Wendell (1811-1884) Letter to "Dear Friend" n.p. n.d.; antislavery, printed letter Oct 23, 1854, signed by Wendell Phillips, recording secretary.

Schoolcraft, Henry Rowe (1793-1864) Author, Antiquarian. Letter to Joseph B. Boyd, New York, 1842 Feb 19, re autographs.

Shillaber, Benjamin Penhallow (1814-1890) Humorist, "Mrs. Partington" Papers, 1850-1890, 19 items.

Thaxter, Celia (1835-1894) Papers 1870, 1891, n.d. 15 items. Poet Isle of Shoals. Three brief letters.

Tilton, Theodore (1835-1907) Letter to H.A. Lambert, "The Independent", New York, April 30, 1961- returns article.

Trowbridge, John Townsend (1827-1916) "Paul Creyton" Letter to "Dear Governor", Arlington, 1907 Oct 16.

Whitman. Walter (Walt) [1852] August 14, Brooklyn. Letter to John Parker Hale urging him to accept the nomination of the Democratic party at Pittsburg.
