Collection of papers, 1806-1924, from several Batchelder family members, mostly receipts and notes from the mid-nineteenth century, but also includes some family correspondence from the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.

It is unclear whether the materials catalogued under all three accession numbers came from the same source. At least part of the collection (M1989-052) was the gift of William Gilmore in 1989, shortly after an auction at the Batchelder Family property in Loudon.

This collection was processed by unknown persons at an unknown time. The finding aid was written by an unknown person at an unknown date but was rewritten and formatted by Sandra L. Collection Overview

Biographical Information

John Batchelder (born 1785) and Jonathan Batchelder (1790-1873), sons of Abraham Bachelder (1744-1836), were born in Loudon, NH. The family surname was spelled variously Batchelder and Bachelder. Jonathan married Anna Sanborn, who died in 1813; he then married Lois Wells, who died in 1881. He was a prominent citizen of Loudon. Jonathan's son, Benjamin (born 1836) resided in Meredith, NH. Nancy Batchelder lived in Loudon, NH, and Martha Batchelder lived in Meredith, NH.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

The Batchelder Family Papers, 1806-1924, consists of correspondence, legal papers, accounts, diaries, and receipts related to the Batchelder family of Loudon, NH and Meredith, NH. Prominent family members mentioned in the papers include: John

Batchelder, Jonathan Batchelder, Benjamin Batchelder, Nancy Batchelder, and Martha Batchelder. Historically, the name has been spelled both Batchelder and Bachelder.

Arrangement:

These papers apparently came to the New Hampshire Historical Society in two parts.

The material from John, Jonathan and other male members of the Batchelder family is in one box, divided into three series:

Series I: John Batchelder, 1811-1866

Series II: Jonathan Batchelder, 1806-1863 Series III: Batchelder Family, 1826-1908

The materials from Martha Bachelder and Nancy Batchelder are filed in the second box, with each woman's separately in chronological order and then general family correspondence in chronological order.
