Collection Overview

Biographical Information/ Administrative Information:

This collection of photographs was gifted to the New Hampshire Historical Society by the Estate of Althea C. Boxell in 1995 several years after the estate was closed. Also included in this gift was a collection of 1507 slides, which is catalogued separately. It is likely, but unknown for certain, that Althea Boxell was the photographer.

Collection Scope and Content Note:

This is a collection of photographs of covered bridges in New Hampshire, taken between approximately the early 1960s and 1990. This estimation is derived from dates on some of the photographs. Many bridges are represented by numerous photographs showing differing views. The bridges are not limited to functional road bridges, but also include bridges over creeks, etc. on private land. Ornamental bridges, such as garden ornaments are included.

Arrangement:

This collection is contained in three file boxes. The folders are arranged alphabetically by the name of the Town.
