BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES:

Orin Bronson of Landaff, NH is listed in the 1850 NH Census. From what can be gathered from his papers, his father Jonathan dealt in lime and was prosperous enough to purchase considerable china and glassware. He may also have been a member of the NH legislature. Orin appears to have been a merchant dealing in lime and grain as well as other commodities. Receipts show that he used the railroads to ship some of his products to Vermont and to various parts of New Hampshire. He was a stockholder in the White Mountains Railroad. He had a brother named Joel who lived in Lyndon.

Gilman Aldrich (1839-1862) was born in Lisbon and resided in Lancaster. He enlisted in the 2nd NH Volunteers in March 1862 and died just a few months later after being captured at Williamsburg, Virginia. His brother Asa Gilman (1845-1864) enlisted in the 58th Mass. Volunteers in December of 1863 and died in June of 1864.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The bulk of the collection is receipts and promissory notes of Orin Bronson from 1846-1897. His diary written in 1872 relates the daily activities of working around the house, chopping wood and carrying milk to Haverhill and Lisbon.

There are a number of other families from the Landaff /Lisbon area represented in this collection. Their relationship, if any, to the Bronsons in unknown. There are letters from the two Aldrich sons and correspondence from family members regarding their deaths in the Civil War. Series III Box 2 folders 2-4 hold the literary efforts of a group of young ladies of the Landaff area. Horace Blake's diary relates activities such as logging, working at the mill, hauling grain, building a barn and the deaths of local people. The Helen P. Foster series contains extensive tracings of deeds and land surveys apparently gathered for a property dispute in the 1930's.

Series V, Box 2 folder 14 contains printed ballots of Presidential and town elections. The earliest of which is from 1926 and the latest 1964. There are three auction broadsides dated 1905-6 and 1945 in the oversize file.
