

BROWN, CYRUS W. (approx 50 items)

This miscellaneous collection was purchased from E. Leslie Byrnes, Jr., Contoocook, N.H. at the auction of the Estate of Florence D. Batchelder (1882-1978), Pittsfield, N.H. The papers consist of railroad material of Cyrus W. Brown and Benjamin Forest Batchelder, personal correspondence, and Florence D. Brown Batchelder's record of work at the Pittsfield, N.H. post office and her inquiries to the Civil Service Commission.

There are personal railroad passes for Brown, a conductor, and his mother, Mrs. L.W. Batchelder, and Brown's receipts for assessments and dues to the Order of Railway Conductors (1910-1912). There are three letters to Cyrus W. Brown from John Horne and his brother Stuart L. Brown concerning to activity and work on the Mt. Washington R.R. and work at the Summit (1900)

There are other items of personal correspondence (1910-1934) and miscellaneous papers. A very detailed list for leather shoe parts (1888) at a Pittsfield factory is included.
