BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

Jane Lee Chworowsky was born Oct. 25, 1929 in Pittsburgh, PA. Her father Martin Chworowsky was a Ph.d. in Education and member of the faculty of the University of Pittsburgh. Jane Lee graduated from Towle High School in Newport, NH in 1947 and attended Plymouth Teachers College. She taught high school English in Charlestown, NH from 1953-1955 and in Cromwell, CT in 1956. She moved to Croyden, NH where she was active in town affairs and ran an antique business. She died in December of 1993.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

These papers were left to the Society in Jane L. Chworowsky's estate. Papers of her father Martin Chworowsky were sent to the Univ. of Pittsburgh. The papers reflect a quiet life of gardening and attending antique auctions. There are detailed records of gas for her car and home heating. There are some materials from the town of Croyden.
