Nathaniel Haven doing everything
Flour mill - railroad meeting at Manchester -
Indian meal = corn mill
3. Nathaniel Clark's Memorandum Book for the Year 1850
4. Nathaniel Clarks Book, 1851
Greenleaf started for Hanover College - then teaching school at Amesbury
Sept - building a new house - masons, joiners, plasters, building the oven
5. Nathaniel Clark's Book - 1852
Nathaniel Haven and Charles doing everything
6. Nathaniel Clark's Book - 1853
Closed the Derry Bank, one of the directors
Building new mill dam
7. Nathaniel Clark's Book - 1854
George (Greenleaf?) and Charles working (?)
Apr 25 - I expect to start for the city of Washington and the South; diary
continued by his wife in his absence - Apr 25 - May 12-
May 13 - Nathaniel back and writing - juryman at Portsmouth

10. Nathaniel Clark's Book 1858-1859
11. Nathaniel Clark's Book 1860 - Jan - Aug 1860 -
seems healthy - last entry Oct 20 in wife's hand
