Papers from Cram house in Exeter. Gift of Mrs. Albert D. Norton, 1965. Additional papers given 1966. Mrs. Edith Wingate Pike Norton is the grand-daughter of Lucinda E. Topham and the great-grand-daughter of Mary Durgin (Mrs. John Durgin) who lived on the Cram place in Exeter.

Joseph Cram of Exeter married Anna Brown in 1780. They had four children, Benjamin (b.1781), Jacob, (b.1783), Anne (b. 1787), Sarah (b.1790). (Hist. Exeter, Family Registers, p. 8)
