SAMUEL D. DOWNES BANK PAPERS 1875-1910 1 Box

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES:

Samuel D. Downes: (b. 1827) was born in Francestown, NH. He was post-master and town clerk in Francestown, and represented the town in the State Legislature. He also served as treasurer of the Francestown Savings Bank. He married Martha T. Billings of South Deerfield, MA (b. 1825). They had one son, William E. Downes (b. 1854).

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTES:

Collection includes routine correspondence and forms accumulated in Downes' capacity as treasurer of the Francestown Savings Bank. Correspondence largely concerns mortgages and loan repayment and requests, but also includes letters regarding the purchase, sale, or foreclosure of properties, and notes pertaining to stocks and investment holdings belonging to the bank. There are two letters that can be considered personal, from C.A. Jaqui--?, on 3 March, 1881 and ND.

Letters from bank clients include some information about the local economic climate, and reflect local culture at the time. There are many interesting bits as to why loans can not be repaid ("need to sell cabbages", "logs were frozen in"). Lawsuits and other legal claims are mentioned as well, including a letter from the Wilton Savings Bank that indicates that both banks were "joint victims in being holders of short time notes" by Cooley and Cole (11 August, 1898). Charles E. Farley writes an extensive letter about the sale of the Saquchee? Company to two gentlemen, and the intention of the buyers to "build up the town" (2 February, 1898). Throughout the correspondence there are indications that the bank had fallen on hard times, and quite a few letters in 1898 include comments on the economic climate ("such times as these"). Correspondence mainly comes from towns in central NH, but other areas on New England and throughout the country are represented as well.

Bank business forms include mainly receipts. There are many collection and remittance notices from the Indian Head National Bank in Nashua, NH for W.E. Downes in 1877 and 1878.
