Will of Stephen Dudley, 17 Feb. 1734/5; return of committee appointed to set off widow's dower, to Hannah, widow of Trueworthy Dudley 3 June 1751; inventory of estate of James Dudley, including cooper's tools, 1746, sale of lands in Brentwood, receipts; Moses Dudley's account of administration of estate of John Dudley and list of notes due, 1805; inventory of estate of Thomas Bean with administrator's account, 1804.
Folder 3	John Dudley - Public ^D usiness, 1763-1790. 28 items. Includes letter from Meshech Weare concerning appointment as referee with John Phillips and himself, 1764; Committee of Safety business, summary of census 1775; letters from Col. David Gilman on appointment of officers, 1776; receipt for money paid troops, 1776; description of skirmish with Indians at Mount Independence; information concerning Stephen Holland and the Loyalists; letters concerning elections, 1787, 1790.
Folder 4	John Dudley - Superior Court, 1784-1796. 25 items. Includes letters from Josiah Bartlett xxxxxxxxxxxx making appointments; from Judges Timothy Farrar, Daniel Newcomb, and Simeon Olcott on difficulty of holding court.
Folder 5	John Dudley - Private Papers, 1754-1804. 22 items. Includes 6 power ^s of attorney, 1757-79; letter from Samuel MacClintock about lumber 1787; two letters from Levi Bartlett, physician, 1797; memorandum book of accounts, 1777-1791.
Folder 6	John Dudley - Invitations, 1791, 1796, undated. 8 items. Invitations to dine from John Langdon, Theodore Atkinson, John Taylor Gilman, Samuel Livermore, John Peirce.

- Folder 7 Massachusetts Items, 1731-1775. 10 items.
Spencer Phipps' report of meeting house in Scituate, 1731; Jacob Cushing, receipt 1748, and order from Selectmen of Hingham to open sawmill dam for passage of fish, 1750; Joseph Otis, deputy sheriff of Suffolk County, keeper of Boston Goal, 6 papers, 1766-1775.
- Folder 8 John Dudley, Jr., - Papers, 1779-1792. 6 items.
Deed to 200 acres of land in Washington, Maine, 1779; letters to parents from Maine, clearing land, sawmill.
- Folder 9 Moses Dudley - Commissions, 1787-1834. 11 items.
Two commissions in the 6th Company, 17th Regiment of militia, as Ensign 1787, and as Second Lieutenant 1788; nine commissions as justice of the peace for the County of Rockingham, 1797, 1802, 1807, 1812, 1816, 1821, 1826, 1829, 1834; was justice of peace and quorum 1829 and 1834.
- Folder 10 Moses Dudley - Correspondence, 1798-1831. 20 items.
Includes Republican (Democratic) party business: a letter appointing a meeting to choose candidate for senator, 1812; printed circulars for 1816 and 1818 elections; letter from William Plumer advocating election of Adams rather than Jackson, Dec. 31, 1827; letters from John Brodhead, Congressman, and Isaac Hill, Senator, 1831. Notification of delinquents in the militia, 1821; a little public and private business.
- Folders 11-12 Moses Dudley - Justice of Peace Papers, 1799-1832. ca. 100 items.
Miscellaneous papers including complaints, warrants, summons, writs of attachment, bills for collection, etc. Cases heard by Moses Dudley as Justice of the Peace.
- Folder 13 Richardson Family Papers, 1786-1829. 12 items.
Receipts; a letter, deeds. (Moses Dudley was probably executor of estate)
- Folder 14 Probate Papers, 1807-1817. 10 items.
Miscellaneous papers; Guardianship of Wadleigh children; Bagley, Edmunds.
- Folder 15 Moses Dudley - Miscellaneous Accounts, 1799-1842. 23 items.
Receipts; booklet summarizing taxes paid 1815-1842; a few accounts and bills; 3 notices of auctions.
- Folder 16 Moses Dudley - Family Papers, 1815-1853. 14 items.
Correspondence with sons: Moses Jr. in Bath, N.Y.; James in Maine and Illinois; Guilford in Pittsburg, Pa. Commissions of Elbridge Gerry Dudley.

DUDLEY DEEDS

- Folder 1 Col. Stephen Dudley to Ebenezer Colcord, 11 Mar. 1727/8. 1 doc.
Grant of 100 acres of land obtained from Capt. Peter Penewit and Abigail, his squaw, by deed of May 11, 1725, and also right in settling Freetown land by power of attorney from John Usher, Jr. of Charles in Massachusetts Bay, May 11, 1720.
- Folder 2 Deeds to John Dudley - Exeter, 1744-1764. 23 deeds.
Deeds of land in Exeter, Brentwood and Epping. Includes a deed from Samuel Magoon to Mary Brown, 1744; and from Susanna Bradley to Davison Dudley, 1747; from John Folsom to Stephen Dudley, 1760; a tripartite agreement between Nicholas Dudley, Jr., John Light and Noah Emery, 1752.
- Folder 3 Deeds to John Dudley - Gilmanton, 1761-1781. 14 deeds.
Land in Gilmanton. Includes 3 deeds of land bought from the Proprietor's tax collector at auction, 1762.
- Folder 4 Deeds to John Dudley - Mills in Raymond, 1749-1798. 6 deeds.
Deeds to parts of sawmills: Freetown Mill, 1749, 1759, 1774, 1777; Dudley Mill, John Haines to Caleb Smith, 1771, to John Dudley, 1773. Also receipt for sale of mill by Caleb Smith, 1785; and receipt for timber to Moses Dudley, 1798.
- Folder 5 Deeds to John Dudley - Raymond, 1751-1800. 45 deeds.
Many of these for small parcels of land near together.
- Folder 6 Dudley Family Deeds, 1757-1817. 19 deeds.
Two deeds of Samuel Dudley, brother of John Dudley, 1757-1763; deeds to John Dudley of land in Candia, Allenstown and in Maine; deeds of land to Moses Dudley, 1788-1817.
