BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

George H. Duncan was born in Leominster, Mass. Dec 23, 1876. He attended Murdock School in Winchendon, Mass. and later received degrees from Amherst College and Dartmouth College. The following are a few of the positions and offices which he held:

- Member of the Constitutional Conventions, 1912-18-30;
- Justice of the Jaffrey District Court, 1913-1915;
- Representative to the NH House, 1915, 23-33, 39-45;
- Treasurer of the Jaffrey Building & Loan Assn, 1917-1934;
- Treasurer of the Annett Box. Company, 1918-42;
- Sec. to U.S. Senator Fred. H. Brown, 1933-35;
- president of the NH Electric Cooperative, 1944-52;
- president of White Mountain Power, 1949-1952.

Along with all the above he found time to hold many town offices such as selectman, tax collector, school board member, etc. In 1900 he married Helen Prescott and they had one son George Prescott Duncan born in 1901.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

With few exceptions this collection reflects Duncan's professional career as President of the New Hampshire Electric Co-operative and White Mountain Power Company. There is correspondence with the Federal Power Commission, the Rural Electrification Administration, The N.H. Water Resources Board and others. One of the few items not resulting from his professional career is the speech given in December 1947. It is a plea for cooperation between the Jaffrey School District and Town to have their meetings coincide.
