Folder 1	Two letters (1898, 1899) written to L.J. Nutting (Levi J. Nutting?), one in July 1898 about an inquiry of family genealogy from a cousin, Mrs. Emily Felch Nichols of Peterborough, NH, and the second in August 1899 about family matters. Another letter to Levi Nutting from Es(?) C. Nutting (1911), a cousin in Townsend, MA. She speaks of a Will and family, Mrs. Amsden, and his children, Sadie and husband with three children, etc.
	Five letters (1916): To Blanche D. Nutting from Isabel Phyllis Kopf in Chicago with calling card. To W.L. Nutting from Edith, greetings. To W.L. Nutting from Alice, greetings. To Mrs. B.D. Nutting from Ellen Dresser, about Gloria. To Miss Blanche Nutting from Lucy, greetings.
Folder 2	Seven letters (1917): To Miss Blanche Nutting in Tarrytown, NY ("The Castle") from Lispenard B. Phister; To Blanche Nutting in Tarrytown from Dick (supposedly at Universtatis of Americas Chatholics) [four letters]; to Blanche from Isabel Kopf, Chicago; to Blanche from Edward Folley, photographer who wants to photograph young ladies.
Folder 3	Undated letters to Blanche from Margo, Hermon, and Dick that indicate they are college friends. Also graduation congratulation cards.
Folder 4	Mostly letters containing personal content to Blanche. From Ruth, Keene, NH; Margo, Northhampton, MA; Janie Scott, Nashua, NH; Mother and Dad, Boston, MA; Claybo, Durham, NH; Erwin (relative?), Charleston, NC in Camp Treene, 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Battalion; Dotty, El Paso, TX; Clay, Portsmouth, NH; Hermon, New Jersey; Mary Alice Douglas, Althea, Indiana;

Letters to Blanche from Myron, New London, CT; from Hermon at Dartmouth College who is in a military drill and has been training his men (5 letters); from Claybo in Portsmouth and Durham (2 letters); from Dick Welch at Dartmouth who is in the hospital and later in hospital in New Haven, CT (?) [2 letters]; from the Good Cheer Society in Nashua, NH; from Norm in the military in college in Durham, NH and later in Burlington, VT (2 letters).
