BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION:

Benjamin Hobbs, dates unknown, married first Deborah Batchelder, second in 1757, Elizabeth Fogg.

David Hobbs, (b. 1760) eldest son of Benjamin. Married first Mary Leavitt, second Charlotte Lord. Their son David, was the father of Dr. Moses L. Hobbs, b. 1800; married Fanny daughter of Simeon Marston, son of Caleb.

Moses Leavitt, dates unknown, married Sarah Towle in 1794. He was originally a tailor, later a fisherman & farmer and operated a grist mill.

David Marston Leavitt, 1810-1870, married Clarrissa Towle

Caleb Marston, dates unknown, married first Jerusha Smith, daughter of Capt. John Smith in May 1737; second, Tabitha Page in Oct, 1740.

Simeon and Abigail Marston were two of Caleb's children. Simeon, (b. 1748) married Elizabeth Dearborn; second Abial Leavitt. Their daughter Fanny married Dr. Moses L. Hobbs.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

There are many early deeds from the Hampton area in this collection. The majority of them relate to the Hobbs Family. The bulk of the Hobbs Family material is receipts and notes of David Hobbs. There is an account of the death of Mary Hobbs, dated March 26, 1785.

There are some interesting letters with political content and from important New Hampshire figures in the correspondence of General Moses Leavitt.

Caleb Marston's will dated 1778 is part of the collection as is Benjamin Hobbs will dated 1793 and the will of a Joseph Lamprey, 1771.

Miscellaneous printed materials include a broadside for raising troops for the Continental Army Listing numbers of recruits to be obtained from each town in Rockingham, Strafford, Cheshire, and Hillsborough counties. A copy of the Manual for the General Court, 1803, pp.17-88. An 1804 broadside re the Republican Committee of Election.
