MASON WEARE TAPPAN PAPERS

Scope and Content Note

Acquisition records for the Mason Weare Tappan Papers are nonexistent. Research correspondence indicates that the papers have been housed at NHHS since at least 1950. The collection consists of two document boxes and spans the years 1846-1869.

Mason Weare Tappan established his reputation as a lawyer quite early in life. After having studied law with his distinguished father and the Hon. George W. Nesmith of Franklin, Tappan was admitted to the bar and acquired an extensive practice in Merrimack and Sullivan Counties. From 1841-1853 his prominence and reputation as a legal advocate were constantly on the increase. It was in the latter year that he first stepped aside from his profession to represent his town in the state legislature, to which he was successively elected in 1853, 1854 and 1855.

In 1855, Tappan was elected as a Republican to the United States Congress. He continued to serve in that capacity until 1861. It was during this time that the "storm of secession" was brewing and all political elements were beginning to warm to the confrontation that was fast approaching. New Hampshire's political leaders were no exception to this and Mason Weare Tappan was considered one of the most outspoken members of Congress. As was said by one of the leading newspapers in the State at the time, he was "active, enthusiastic, and always conciliatory where conciliation is needed. With a heart forced by its very nature to hate falsehood, oppression and wrong, he is just the man whom a free people should delight to honor, and in honoring whom they must honor themselves."¹

When the country had finally reached the period of Civil War and Abraham Lincoln had called for seventy-five thousand volunteers for three months, Mason Weare Tappan was one of the first men in the State to enlist. The command of the First Regiment naturally went to him, and he was accordingly appointed and commissioned by Governor Berry. Even though the regiment only served three months, it acquired the reputation as the leading regiment on the right of the army in its extended operations in Maryland and Virginia. Of Colonel Tappan, New Hampshire in the Rebellion says: "As a commander he was patriotic, brave and thoughtful of and kind to his officers and men, and respected by all."²

Tappan returned to Concord, New Hampshire where he resumed his practice of law and served as Attorney General of the State of New Hampshire for ten years from 1876-1886. Mason Weare Tappan died in Bradford, New Hampshire on October 24, 1886.

The collection consists largely of correspondence and is arranged chronologically. The largest bulk of the papers are from the war years 1861-1865 and concern mostly business and political matters. Correspondents of note in the collection include Samuel Bell, William E. Chandler, Jacob Ela, George G. Fogg, Joseph A. Gilmore, William H. Gove, Larkin D. Mason, Gilman Marston, Austin L. Pike, Oliver Pillsbury, E. H. Rollins and Amos Tuck. A complete listing of correspondents by box is appended to the inventory of this register.

Note: On August 20, 1982, accession records were found for the Mason Weare Tappan Papers. The papers were purchased in November, 1930 from R. W. Small (?) of Newburyport, Massachusetts (see Collection File 1982-20). Because this record was not available when the collection was processed and cataloged, a new accession number was assigned (1982-20). The collection will continue to be housed under the most recent number. The original accession records were found in the Museum/Library Accession Record Book for 1930.

Biographical Sketch

- 1817 . October 20, born in Newport, New Hampshire, the son of Weare and Lucinda (Atkins) Tappan
attended the Hopkinton and Meriden Academies
studied law with his father, Weare Tappan and George W. Nesmith of Franklin, New Hampshire
- 1841 was admitted to the New Hampshire Bar and commenced practice with his father in Bradford, New Hampshire. Maintained an office in Concord, as well.
- 1848 May 2, married Emeline M. Worth of Bradford, N.H.
- 1850 February 1, son, Frank Mason Tappan, born
- 1853-1855 served in the New Hampshire State House of Representatives
- 1855-1861 . elected as a Republican to the Thirty-Fourth, Thirty-fifth, and Thirty-Sixth United States Congresses
- 1855-1859 served on the Judiciary Committee, United State Congress
- 1860 received the honorary A.M. degree from Dartmouth College
- 1860-1861 served as Chairman of the Committee on Claims, United States Congress. Was also appointed a member of the celebrated Committee of Thirty-Three, set up to advise the President concerning impending national disturbances
- 1860-1861 served again in the New Hampshire State House of Representatives
- 1861 May-August, served in the Union Army as Colonel of the First Regiment, New Hampshire Volunteer Infantry
- 1861-1876 resumed practice of law in Concord, although residing in Bradford, New Hampshire
