BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

When Bryant F. Tolles began this project he was the Assistant Director of the New Hampshire Historical Society. He left NHHS to become Director at the Essex Institute in Salem, Massachusetts, and later became associated with the Museum Studies Program at the University of Delaware.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

New Hampshire Architecture: an illustrated guide (also known as the Guidebook to New Hampshire Architecture) is a popular guide to residential, ecclesiastical, civic, industrial, educational and commercial structures. Line drawings of architectural features supplement the photographs and maps. It was published in 1979 for the New Hampshire Historical Society by the University Press of New England.

Series I, publication records, includes the original proposal and survey sheets for data collection. It includes information on funding sources. Materials edited from the final edition are here in folders 6-8. Samples of publicity and book reviews are located here.

Series II includes all correspondence generated in locating a publisher and with the chosen publisher as well as general correspondence regarding the project. Series IIA contains the correspondence arranged by county and town locating structures and verifying data. Counties are arranged alphabetically as found in Tolles files.

Series III consists of the data sheets and photographs. It represents the bulk of the collection. It is arranged by County in the same order in which they appear in the final printing of the Guidebook.

The negatives for all the photographs with the data sheets were removed to the Special Collections department. Copies from secondary source materials were given to the New Hampshire Office for Historic Preservation.
